

## QUILT CATEGORIES

**CHALLENGE** – Special category. (Does NOT require entry of Quilting Method).

**TRADITIONAL** – Quilt is made using classic patterning and techniques.

- **TRADITIONAL PIECED:** Piecing predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.



- **TRADITIONAL APPLIQUE:** Appliqué predominates over other techniques in amount or effect.



- **TRADITIONAL MIXED:** A quilt where a fairly even amount of both piecwork and appliqué is used to develop the design of the top.



- **TRADITIONAL PICTORIAL:** A quilt that represents a recognizable image of a person, place, or thing; any size.



(Based on a pattern & technique in a workshop.)

- **TRADITIONAL OTHER:** A quilt where one special technique is used to develop the design of the top such as whole cloth (with or without trapunto), crazy quilt, cathedral window, embroidered, collage threadwork, etc.



**ART/INNOVATIVE** – Quilt made using original design reflecting innovative construction and design techniques, theme or subject matter, and/or materials. (No commercial patterns or copies of previous works).



**WEARABLE** – Garment made using quilted fabric. (Does NOT require entry of Quilting Method).



**ACCESSORIES/DECOR**– Pillow, tree skirt, table runner, purse, bag, etc., made using quilted fabric. (Does NOT require entry of Quilting Method).
